Shasta District Fair Independent Exhibitor Rules

Age Requirements: Livestock Department Independent Exhibitors must be at least 9 years of age and must not be older than 18 years of age on January 1, 2025.

Ownership Requirements: Independent Exhibitors must meet all ownership requirements. Independent Exhibitors must enter in an open Junior or Independent class unless one is not available. If an open or Independent class is not available, junior exhibitors may enter an appropriate 4-H, FFA, or Grange Class.

Parent/Guardian Signature on the entry form is required by the fair to certify that: projects have been under their direct supervision in accordance with the rules and regulations of the fair; and the entry is the project of the exhibitors and is eligible for exhibit. Failure or refusal of parent/guardian to sign the required entry form will prevent the exhibitor from entering that particular class(es).

Leaving an Organization: Juniors who have been a 4-H, FFA or Grange project member within 60 days (120 days for horse and market beef) prior to the fair are not eligible to compete in that project as an independent.

Record Book: All independent exhibitors must have project management records (as provided by the Shasta District Fair) and proof of supervision available as to the length of the project.

Picture and Bill of Sale: Independent Junior exhibitors entering market animals must provide fair management with a picture of their animal, appropriate proof of ownership, permanent ear tag, tattoo and /or hog ear notch information 120 days prior to the fair for beef and 60 days for sheep or swine. Mail to: SDF, 1890 Briggs St, Anderson, CA 96007.

On Grounds Supervision: All independent exhibitors must have "on grounds" supervision by a responsible adult. The names of the responsible adults must be on file with the livestock office.

*NOTE: All independent exhibitors MUST check in with the appropriate 'Barn Supervisor' twice each day (6-8 am and 6-8 pm) for the run of the fair; failure to do so will result in the following: 1st offense will receive a warning letter, 2nd offense will result in being excused from the fair and auction. If Barn Supervisor not available independent exhibitor must check in with Livestock office.

Barn Duty/Feeding: All independent exhibitors must participate in barn duty. All animals must be fed and watered in a timely manner. Animals not fed or watered in a timely manner will be excused from the fair and auction.

Uniform: The show "uniform" for independent exhibitors will be dark black pants, a white button-down shirt with sleeves, and closed toed shoes.

Class Size: If there are insufficient entries in the independent junior classes to warrant adequate competition, Independent Junior classes may be combined with other divisions at the Fair Management's discretion.

Insurance Coverage: Exhibitors shall provide insurance coverage as required by the fair – no later than June 6th. Independent exhibitors must provide the fair office with a certificate of insurance showing proof of one million dollars liability coverage on the animal to be exhibited or purchase insurance through CFSA.
